Standards of Training and Certification of Watch keeping (STCW) - Basic Safety Training 2010

Basic Safety Training is a legal requirement for anyone looking for commercial work aboard a vessel at sea, in accordance with the STCW code A-VI/1

The training program consists of 5 modules which can be done concurrently or on an individual basis, these are:

- ***Personal Survival Techniques (STCW A-VI/1-1) 1 day***
Essential sea survival training to deal with a range of emergency situations. Includes the launch of a life raft, using safety equipment, and the techniques for surviving at sea both in and out of life rafts and how to summon help.
- ***Fire Fighting and Fire Prevention (STCW A-VI/1-2) 2 days***
Identifies the different types of fire that can occur on board and how to prevent them, the selection and use of the appropriate extinguishers. Practical training includes use of firefighting equipment and breathing apparatus to extinguish fires and complete a casualty evacuation in a smoke filled environment.
- ***Elementary First Aid (STCW A-VI/1-3) 1 day***
A mixture of theory and practical sessions on how to respond to the most common emergencies on board. You will learn to conduct a primary survey carry out CPR, and use an AED plus how to control bleeding, manage broken bones, burns and treat shock.
- ***Personal Safety and Social Responsibility (STCW A-VI/1-4) 1 day***
An introduction to accident prevention and safety procedures including alarms and signals. It also covers your rights at work, employment conditions and work practices such as safe working, pollution prevention and relations with others on board.
- ***Maritime Security Awareness (STCW A-VI/6-1) ½ day***
Provides knowledge, understanding and proficiency for personnel intending to work on ships who will not have any designated security duties.

FTA approved certification valid for 5 years will be issued upon successful completion of all 5 modules.
