



NOTICE TO MARINERS

Sub: Removal of SBM at Hulaylah Terminal for Temporary Maintenance

Ref : BA Chart 3174, attached Chartlet 3174

Please be notified that ISEAS L.L.C on behalf of RAK Gas LLC are scheduled to remove the SBM at Hulaylah Offshore Terminal located in position:

- Latitude : 25° 58' 31.6"N
- Longitude : 055° 56' 16.5"E

The SBM will be towed to Al Jazeera Port and is expected to be off station for at least two years.

The job is scheduled to commence on 25th June and will take around 7-10 days. The subsea equipment on the seabed such as pipeline, PLEM, 6 x SBM anchor chains will be left in place and anchor chains will be fixed to six sinker blocks.

Crane Barge ***Badr*** supported by ***Tug Duma*** will be conducting diving operations at the SBM and will require an exclusion zone of 0.5nm radius. T-Duma will maintain a constant listening watch on VHF channel 16 & 14, display appropriate signals, and hoist Flag Alpha during diving operations to alert nearby vessels.

All Mariners are requested to exercise extreme caution while transiting in the vicinity:

- Vessels/crafts/fishing boats to keep clear of the above exclusion zone, proceed with minimum speed and navigate with caution.
- Maintain constant listening watch on VHF Channel **16 / 14**.
