



NOTICE TO MARINERS

No. 16 – 14 August 2023

Sub: A five-metre platform protrusion from Saqr Port's Berth 5 to seaward

Ref: Saqr Port Berths 5

Please be advised that a temporary platform protruding approximately five metres to seaward from the quay wall at Saqr Port Berth 5 is firmly mounted on the berth (see image on page below). This is to facilitate the installation of an upgraded ship loader onto the quayside.

The platform will remain in place until the project is completed, which includes geotechnical soil investigation, and is expected to take about two months to complete. During this period, the berth is idle for loading and mooring operations.

Vessels arriving at and departing from nearby berths, including supply boats, should exercise caution while manoeuvring in the area and maintain a distance of at least twenty-five metres from the platform. No vessels shall attempt to moor at or approach this berth until the berth is declared fully operational.
