Sub: Multi-Party Marine Charges - Responsibility of Marine Agent

To: RAK Ports Marine Agents

**Ship Owners, Managers and Operators** 

Please be advised that commencing on the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2025 all Marine Charges will be applied to a single point of contact - the Marine Agent responsible for the vessel's registration.

In the event of any shifts or other special marine operations involving the vessel, charges will not be divided among multiple third parties. Instead, all charges will be applied solely to the marine agency under which the vessel is registered. This measure is intended to facilitate smooth operations for all parties and to prevent duplication of approvals or refusals related to these charges.

It is the responsibility of the registering agency to recover / collect any associated costs from the party that initiated the request.

Note: Regarding Bunkering and D.G.P.E (Oil Drums) services, invoices will be submitted directly to bunker suppliers, as is currently the practice.
